Section 1 Purpose

To maintain the various church Information Technology systems.

Section 2 Membership

The Information Technology (IT) Committee shall consist of at least four members but not more than six members. Members shall serve three-year terms and are eligible for re-election by the church. The Nominating Committee shall submit candidates for committee membership to the church with the advice of the current Information Technology Committee.

Section 3 Chair

The Information Technology (IT) Committee members shall select their own Chairperson. The Chairperson shall serve a one-year term and may be selected to serve consecutive terms.

Section 4 Function

The Information Technology (IT) Committee shall be responsible for:

- 1. Purchase and maintenance or leasing of all staff and church office computer systems, tablets, copiers, printers and related software and accessories.
- 2. Assigning and maintaining staff or other church email accounts.
- 3. Purchase and maintenance of the church internet and WIFI network and associated account.
- 4. Purchase and maintenance of staff cell phones and accounts.
- 5. Purchase and maintenance of the church telephone system and account.

- 6. Purchase and maintenance of the church security camera system.
- 7. Submittal to Audio-Visual Committee pertinent information on equipment purchased or discarded if in excess of \$50 so that the equipment can be logged into the AV Inventory list.
- 8. Preparing a yearly budget request and providing the request to the Finance Committee.
- 9. Working in coordination with the Audio-Visual Committee and Website Committee as necessary to ensure the technology needs of the church are properly addressed.
