Policy 3250, Employee Benefits for part time salaried non-called custodians. Page 1 of 2

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- 1. Part time non-called custodians shall not be eligible for life, health, or disability insurance.
- 2. Part time non-called custodians are not eligible for housing allowance.
- 3. Part time non-called custodians are not eligible for church provided cell phones.
- 4. Part time non-called custodians shall not be eligible for retirement.
- 5. Part time non-called custodians shall be eligible for paid vacation leave.
 - A. Twenty (20) hours of vacation will be earned annually by part time non-called custodians with less than 13 months of service.
 - B. Forty (40) hours of vacation will be earned annually by part time non-called custodians with 13 months of service or more.
 - C. Custodians becomes eligible for additional vacation benefit beginning the month following their 12 month anniversary.
 - D. Retiring employees will be paid for leave accumulated but unused.
 - E. All vacation must be used before the end of each calendar year. Any unused vacation hours will be forfeited.

- 6. All salaried staff members are eligible for sick leave benefits. To accommodate the employee's protection of personal health, employees will earn sick leave benefits according to the following plan.
 - A. Each part time custodian will earn sick leave at the rate of two (2) hours per month to a maximum of sixty (60) hours. The sick leave can only be used on days that the part time custodian would normally work.
 - B. Sick leave can be used for custodian's illness, medical appointments, and similar needs of immediate family members for whom the custodian has care-giver responsibilities.
