- 1. It is the policy of Poplar Springs Baptist Church that the Minister of Youth and Children have the following education and required training:
 - A. Graduate level coursework in religious studies or similar experience in a church setting.
 - B. Previous related experience teaching Bible studies and working with youth or children preferred.
 - C. It is preferred that the Minister of Youth and Children have proven experience in a comparable position.
- 2. The Minister of Youth and Children reports to the pastor.
- 3. The Minister of Youth and Children shall have routine communications with the children and youth of the church.
- 4. The Minister of Youth and Children shall have weekly communication with the pastor and other church staff members at the Weekly Staff Planned Meeting.
- 5. The Minister of Youth and Children shall have the following specific job duties and responsibilities:
 - A. Coordinate and schedule meetings with the Children's council and the Youth council to set goals and plan activities for the year.
 - B. Set priorities for the children and youth's ministries in the areas of Fellowship, Worship, Evangelism, Discipleship, and Ministry.
 - C. Maintain a calendar of events for the children and youth ministries, ensuring appropriate activities are planned for the year which capture the children and youth's interests and attention while maintaining a Christian focus.
 - D. Seek to lead the children and the youth into a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ.

- E. Coordinate, plan, and participate in the activities and mission projects of the children and youth.
- F. Promote and expect the active participation and involvement of parents in the children's and youth's ministries of the church.
- G. Work with the ministerial staff in planning the worship services of the church.
- H. Coordinate and lead the worship services on Wednesday night, with assistance from parents, and other church members as is desired. Lead devotion time on Sunday night before youth choir.
- I. Be in charge of Children's Church, again using parents if desired.
- J. Cooperatively perform other responsibilities as the job requires from time to time.
- K. Perform background checks for children and youth volunteers and enforce all other aspects of policy 5100.
- L. Coordinate spiritual retreats devotions.
- M. Coordinate and host youth leadership development training biannually.
- N. Collect, record, and track funds received and balances due for youth accounts.
